The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) Office of Inspector General will remain open during any lapse in appropriations. Assessments paid to the Deposit Insurance Fund by insured institutions, and administered by the FDIC, fund both the FDIC and the FDIC Office of Inspector General. Because the Deposit Insurance Fund is not derived from the U.S. Treasury, the FDIC remains funded during lapses of appropriations. The ongoing operation of the FDIC requires the continued operation of the FDIC Office of Inspector General during any government shutdown.
